AN ACT PROVIDING THAT POLICE APPOINTING AUTHORITIES MAY
APPOINT PARKING CONTROL OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 147 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 10E thereof, the following section:—
3 *Section 10F.* Any board or officer authorized to appoint
4 police officers in any city, town or district may appoint parking
5 control officers who shall have only the powers and duties of
6 police officers conferred or imposed by section twenty A of
7 chapter ninety of the General Laws, to enforce those laws, rules
8 and regulations which regulate, direct, control or restrict the
9 stopping or standing of vehicles in public ways and in off-street
10 parking areas and facilities deemed to be ways under the con-
11 trol of such city, town or district. Officers appointed under the
12 provisions of this section shall be subject to the provisions of
13 chapter thirty-one.
