AN ACT REQUIRING APPOINTING AUTHORITIES TO PERMANENTLY
FILL ALL VACANCIES IN PERMANENT POSITIONS BEFORE THE CIVIL
SERVICE LISTS ESTABLISHED FOR SUCH POSITION EXPIRES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 15 of chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after paragraph C, as amended by
3 section 9 of chapter 643 of the acts of 1955, the following
4 paragraph:—

5 D. Appointing authorities shall permanently fill all vacan-
6 cies in permanent civil service positions as classified in section
7 forty-five of chapter thirty of the General Laws before the
8 civil service lists established for such positions expire.
