

Chap. 47. AN ACT DESIGNATING A PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 2 AS THE MINUTEMAN HIGHWAY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

That portion of state highway route 2 from the Alewife Brook parkway in the city of Cambridge and extending westerly to the rotary traffic circle at the Massachusetts reformatory in the town of Concord shall be known and designated as the Minuteman highway and suitable markers bearing said designation shall be erected and maintained along said highway by the department of public works.

Chap. 48. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE ON ROUTE 140 OVER BRALEY ROAD IN THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD AS THE PRIVATE ANNIBAL AGUIAR BRIDGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The bridge on state highway route 140 over Braley road in the city of New Bedford shall be known and designated as the Private Annibal Aguiar bridge, in memory of Annibal Aguiar, who was killed in action while a member of the armed forces of the United States in World War II. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public works.

Chap. 49. AN ACT CREATING THE AUBURN ARENA AUTHORITY AND PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF AN INDOOR HOCKEY AND SKATING RINK IN THE TOWN OF AUBURN BY SAID AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The Authority created by section two is hereby authorized to take by eminent domain or acquire by purchase or otherwise land with or without buildings thereon in the town of Auburn, and to construct, maintain and operate thereon, an arena for the purpose of providing an indoor hockey and skating rink for use primarily by individuals, and school and amateur teams, in the town of Auburn; provided, however, that during the months of May, June, July, August and September in each year and at such other times as there is no substantial demand for the use of such arena or any part thereof as such a rink, the Authority may permit the use of such arena or part thereof for other purposes as provided in this act.

SECTION 2. There is hereby created a public body politic and corporate to be known as the Auburn Arena Authority, hereinafter called the Authority, which is hereby constituted a public instrumentality; and the exercise by the Authority of the powers conferred by this act shall be deemed and held to be the performance of essential governmental functions and the Authority shall not be liable for any injury, loss or damage suffered by any person or property by reason of any ordinary or gross negligence of the Authority or any of its officers, employees or agents.
