AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ESSEX COUNTY TO TRANSFER A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN MIDDLETON FROM THE ESSEX COUNTY TUBERCULOSIS HOSPITAL DISTRICT TO SAID COUNTY FOR USE IN THE OPERATION OF THE ESSEX COUNTY INDUSTRIAL FARM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county of
2 Essex, acting in their capacity as trustees of the Essex county
3 tuberculosis hospital district, are hereby authorized to transfer
4 to the county of Essex, a certain parcel of land held by them for
5 hospital purposes, in Middleton, Massachusetts, not exceeding
6 thirty acres. Said transfer shall take effect upon acceptance
7 thereof by vote of the county commissioners of Essex county.
8 Thereafter so much of said land as is transferred hereunder shall
9 be under the control and charge of the county commissioners
10 and shall be developed and maintained by them for use in the
11 operation of the Essex county industrial farm.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance
2 by the county commissioners of Essex county but not otherwise.
