AN ACT REQUESTING SUBJECT PLANS WITH FEWER THAN TWENTY-FIVE EMPLOYEES UNDER THE HEALTH, WELFARE AND RETIREMENT TRUST FUNDS LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 2 of chapter 151D of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in section 4 of chapter 655 of the acts of 1958,
3 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "chapter", in
4 line 5, the following: — ; provided, however, that any subject
5 plan having fewer than twenty-five employee participants sub-
6 sequent to registration shall nevertheless comply with the pro-
7 visions of said chapter.
