AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE INTERSECTION OF THE CHARLES RIVER DAM, MONSIGNOR O'BRIEN HIGHWAY, COMMERCIAL AVENUE AND THE APPROACH TO THE PRISON POINT BRIDGE IN CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized and
2 directed to make improvements to the intersection of the Charles
3 River dam, Monsignor O'Brien highway, Commercial avenue
4 and the approach to the Prison Point bridge in Cambridge,
5 also the widening of the Monsignor O'Brien highway in a west-
6 erly direction from the above intersection to Lechmere square
7 in order to relieve congestion, and to expedite the flow of
8 vehicular traffic and to promote the safety of the public. For
9 the purposes of this act said commission may expend such sums
10 as may be appropriated.
