### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CONTINUITY OF OFFICE IN CASE OF A VACANCY CAUSED BY RESIGNATION OR DEATH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 30 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by inserting at the end the following sentence: —  
3 In the case of resignation or death of the designator and where  
4 his duties are not specially authorized by law to be performed by  
5 another person, the authority given by the designator shall con-  
6 tinue until revoked by his successor.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 6 of chapter 30 of the General Laws  
2 is hereby further amended by striking out the word "may" in  
3 the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the word "shall".
