AN ACT REQUIRING ALL MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE TO BE NON-CANCELLABLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
2 after section 193H, as inserted by chapter 426 of the acts of 1962,
3 the following section: —

4 *Section 193I.* No policy of insurance for coverage of an owner
5 of a motor vehicle, whether for liability for damage or injury to
6 others, or for damage to said vehicle, shall be valid unless it shall
7 contain a provision that said policy is not cancellable by the com-
8 pany except for nonpayment of premium or fraud.
