AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RECORDING OF ZONING ORDINANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 40A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 adding after section 6 the following section:—
3 *Section 6A.* A true copy of the zoning ordinance or by-
4 law, and any map referred to therein together with their
5 recent amendments shall be kept on file available for inspec-
6 tion in the office of the clerk of the city or town. A copy certi-
7 fied by such clerk of any such ordinance or by-law and any
8 map referred to therein together with their recent amend-
9 ments shall be transmitted forthwith by such clerk to the
10 register of deeds and recorder of the land court, and after
11 January first, nineteen hundred and sixty-two no zoning ordi-
12 nance or by-law or any map referred to therein or their
13 amendments shall be binding and effective unless and until
14 such certified copies have been so recorded and filed.

For the purpose of providing for the better government of the Territory of Alaska, and for other purposes, the following provisions are enacted: That the following provisions shall be binding and effective as if they were contained in the laws of the United States.

The Government of Alaska

As the first step toward the better government of the Territory of Alaska, the following provisions are enacted:

1. That the Governor of Alaska shall be elected by the people of the Territory for a term of four years, and shall hold office until the expiration of his term.

2. That the Governor shall have the honor and the power of a full and complete pardon, subject to the approval of the Senate, in all cases where the law so provides.

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
