AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF COURT STENOGRAPHERS IN TRIALS
BY A JURY OF SIX IN THE THIRD DISTRICT COURT OF EASTERN
MIDDLESEX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 The fifth paragraph of section 1 of chapter 457 of the acts
2 of 1962, as most recently amended by chapter 143 of the
3 acts of 1964, is hereby further amended by adding at the end
4 thereof the following:—A defendant shall not be entitled
5 to the services of a court stenographer in any trial under this
6 section.
