AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF A SECOND ASSISTANT REGISTER OF DEEDS IN THE COUNTY OF NORFOLK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 36 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
- 2 out section 6, as appearing in section 3 of chapter 76I of the acts
- 3 of 1960, and inserting in place thereof the following section:—
- 4 *Section 6.* The registers for the southern district of Essex,
- 5 the county of Hampden, the county of Norfolk and the Worcester
- 6 district may, with the approval of their respective county com-
- 7 missioners, appoint and at pleasure remove a second assistant
- 8 register. Such an assistant shall have all the powers and au-
- 9 thority vested in an assistant register.
