AN ACT REQUIRING THE STATE TREASURER TO PAY THE CITY OF TAUNTON A SUM OF MONEY FOR ADDITIONAL REIMBURSEMENT FOR VETERANS SERVICES FOR THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-THREE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state treasurer shall, from funds appropriated for the re-
2 imbursement of cities and towns for veterans services under the
3 provisions of section six of chapter one hundred and fifteen of
4 the General Laws, pay to the city of Taunton the sum of twenty-
5 three thousand eight hundred and forty-six dollars and forty-five
6 cents as additional reimbursement for veterans' services fur-
7 nished by said city for the year nineteen hundred and sixty-three.
