## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN REIMBURSEMENT TO EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH WHO TRAVEL IN THE COURSE OF THEIR DUTIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The second paragraph of section 28 of chapter 7 of the Gen-  
2 eral Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 352 of the  
3 acts of 1963, is hereby further amended by adding at the end  
4 thereof the following sentence:—Such rules shall contain a  
5 provision that an employee entitled to travel expenses as pro-  
6 vided herein shall, in addition, be reimbursed for the actual  
7 costs of highway tolls paid by him while travelling in the course  
8 of his duties.
