RESOLUTIONS SUPPORTING THE DEMAND OF THE PEOPLE OF CHARLESTOWN FOR URBAN RENEWAL.

1 *Whereas*, The Massachusetts house of representatives has
2 supported the renewal efforts in Charlestown by providing the
3 adequate legislation for the execution of the Charlestown re-
4 newal project; and

5 *Whereas*, The overwhelming majority of Charlestown resi-
6 dents voted decisively in support of the renewal program on
7 Sunday, March fourteenth; and

8 *Whereas*, The citizens of Charlestown in lawful petition of
9 five thousand residents of Charlestown requested and received
10 the wholehearted support of Mayor John F. Collins of the City
11 of Boston; and

12 *Whereas*, The house of representatives has always respected
13 the just petitions of the people of the commonwealth; therefore
14 be it

15 *Resolved*, That the house of representatives in response to the
16 people of Charlestown, recognize and support their overwhelm-
17 ing demand for an urban renewal program, and endorse their
18 petition for immediate action to rescue their historic community
19 from blight and decline.
