RESOLUTIONS CONGRATULATING THE TOWN OF CHARLEMONT ON THE OCCASION OF ITS TWO HUNDREDTH ANNIVERSARY.

1 *Whereas*, The town of Charlemont will celebrate its two hun-
2 dredth anniversary of its establishment during the current year;
3 and

4 *Whereas*, The people of the town of Charlemont from its
5 earliest days have contributed to the community and the com-
6 monwealth and have exemplified the highest traditions of our
7 commonwealth; and

8 *Whereas*, Charlemont has maintained a strong agricultural
9 tradition, a firm commitment to popular representative govern-
10 ment beginning with its first town meeting on January six,
11 seventeen hundred and sixty-six, and a distinguished citizenry
12 including its first settler, Captain Moses Rice; and

13 *Whereas*, The celebration of the two hundredth anniversary of
14 the establishment of the town of Charlemont is of historical
15 significance not only to the town but also to the commonwealth;
16 therefore be it

17 *Resolved*, That the Massachusetts house of representatives
18 hereby extends its congratulations and best wishes to the town
19 of Charlemont; and be it further

20 *Resolved*, That an engrossed copy of the resolutions be sent by
21 the secretary of the commonwealth to the town clerk of the town
22 of Charlemont to be filed with the records of said town.
