**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the city of Pittsfield is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with CRT Real Estate Corporation and the Central Renewal Corporation, both Massachusetts corporations, whereby the said city shall acquire the real estate known as the Old Central Fire Station and in consideration thereof the said city shall lease certain property on Depot street in said city to the said corporation in accordance with the terms of said agreement.

**SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chapter 234. AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN APPOINTED BOARD OF HEALTH IN THE TOWN OF MANCHESTER-BY-THE-SEA.**

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The board of health in the town of Manchester-by-the-sea shall consist of three members who shall be appointed by the board of selectmen and shall serve for terms of three years. Members of the board of health now in office shall serve until their terms expire.

**Chapter 235. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MILLIS TO REVOKE ITS ACCEPTANCE OF CERTAIN LAWS.**

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the town of Millis, acting by and through its town meeting, is hereby authorized to revoke the acceptance of sections sixty-nine C to sixty-nine F, inclusive, of chapter forty-one of the General Laws as voted by the annual town meeting of said town held on March twenty-third, nineteen hundred and seventy.

**Chapter 236. AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE IN THE CITY OF NEWTON AS THE AMERICAN EX-PRISONERS OF WAR BRIDGE.**
