RESOLVE AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DIVISION OF WATERWAYS, TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A RECREATION AREA ON THE MERRIMACK RIVER IN THE CITY OF HAVERHILL.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works, division of
2 waterways, shall make an investigation and study of current
3 house document numbered 3049, authorizing the department of
4 natural resources to construct a beach and recreation area with
5 a swimming pool and skating rink on the Merrimack river in
6 the city of Haverhill. Said department shall report to the gen-
7 eral court the results of its investigation and study, and its
8 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation
9 necessary to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing
10 the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or
11 before the last Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and
12 sixty-five.
