By Mr. Longworth of Methuen (by request), petition of John J. Scannell and others (by vote of the town of Methuen) that said town be authorized to compensate Mae E. Press for loss of wages and medical bills resulting from an injury sustained by her in the municipal town building. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF METHUEN TO PAY COMPENSATION TO, AND CERTAIN MEDICAL BILLS OF, MAE E. PRESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation,
2 the town of Methuen is hereby authorized to pay to Mae E.
3 Press, an employee of the welfare department of said town, a
4 sum not to exceed sixty-one hundred forty-three dollars and
5 thirty-eight cents as compensation for loss of wages and medical
6 bills resulting from an injury sustained by her on March fifth,
7 nineteen hundred and sixty-three in the municipal town build-
8 ing, while in the performance of her duty as an employee of the
9 welfare department.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

1. The Governor of the State.

2. The Secretary of the State.

3. The Superintendent of the State.

4. The Commissioner of the State.

5. The Director of the State.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
