AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ASSISTANT CLERK IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF WESTERN NORFOLK WHOSE SALARY SHALL BE PAYABLE BY THE COUNTY, AND A SECOND ASSISTANT CLERK IN THE FIRST DISTRICT COURT OF SOUTHERN MIDDLESEX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 10 of chapter 218 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out the second and third
3 sentences and inserting in place thereof the following two
4 sentences:— Assistant clerks with salaries payable by the
5 county may be appointed in the central district court of north-
6 ern Essex, the municipal court of the Charlestown district, the
7 municipal court of the Brighton district, the district court of
8 western Hampden, the district court of Newton, the district
9 court of northern Norfolk, the district court of Chicopee, the
10 municipal court of Brookline, the first district court of southern
11 Middlesex, the first district court of Barnstable, the district
12 court of western Norfolk, and in courts the judicial districts of
13 which have, according to the national or state census last pre-
14 ceding, a population of sixty thousand or more. Second assistant
15 clerks with salaries payable by the county may be appointed
16 in the municipal court of the Roxbury district, the East Boston
17 district court, the municipal court of the Charlestown district,
18 the municipal court of the Dorchester district, the municipal
19 court of the Brighton district, the municipal court of the West
20 Roxbury district, the municipal court of the South Boston
21 district, the central district court of Worcester, the district
22 court of Newton, and, subject to the approval of the county
23 commissioners, in the first district court of eastern Middlesex,
24 the first district court of southern Middlesex, the third district
25 court of eastern Middlesex, the district court of Lowell, the first

26 district court of Essex, the district court of southern Essex, the
27 central district court of northern Essex, the district court of
28 Springfield, the second district court of Bristol, the third dis-
29 trict court of Bristol, the district court of East Norfolk, the
30 district court of Somerville and the district court of Chelsea.
