1 *Ordered*, That the joint committee on counties is hereby
2 authorized to sit during the recess of the general court for
3 the purpose of making an investigation and study of the
4 subject matter of current house document numbered 2079,
5 authorizing the borrowing of money for constructing and
6 equipping a court house in the town of Concord for the dis-
7 trict court of Concord. Said committee shall be provided with
8 quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings,
9 and may expend for clerical and other assistance and for
10 expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said
11 committee shall report to the general court the results of its
12 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
13 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said
14 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk
15 of the house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday
16 of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
