### AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN DISTRICT ATTORNEYS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 12 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by striking out the second paragraph, as  
3 amended by section 1 of chapter 185 of the acts of 1957, and  
4 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—

5 For the Suffolk district, twenty-nine assistant district at-  
6 torneys.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 14 of said chapter 12 is hereby fur-  
2 ther amended by striking out the fifth paragraph, as amended  
3 by section 1 of chapter 741 of the acts of 1960, and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following paragraph:—

5 For the middle district, eight assistant district attorneys.

1 SECTION 3. Section 16 of said chapter 12 is hereby amended  
2 by striking out the second paragraph, as amended by section 2  
3 of chapter 743 of the acts of 1963, and inserting in place thereof  
4 the following paragraph:—

5 For the Suffolk district, one assistant, twelve thousand nine  
6 hundred dollars; two assistants, twelve thousand seven hun-  
7 dred dollars; four assistants, ten thousand seven hundred dol-  
8 lars; two assistants, nine thousand six hundred dollars; five  
9 assistants, nine thousand dollars; ten assistants, eight thousand  
10 dollars; and five assistants, seven thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 4. Said section 16 of said chapter 12 is hereby fur-  
2 ther amended by striking out the fifth paragraph, as appearing  
3 in section 3 of chapter 741 of the acts of 1960, and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following paragraph: —

5 For the middle district, one assistant, nine thousand five hun-  
6 dred dollars; one assistant, eight thousand five hundred dollars;  
7 and six assistants, seven thousand five hundred dollars.
