AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE USE OF A VOTER COMPUTER SYSTEM AT CERTAIN TOWN ELECTIONS IN THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 3 selectmen and town clerk, to use a voter computer system with
- 4 automatic tabulating equipment at its annual town election in
- 5 the year nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
