Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 40A of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-

3 *Section 7B.* A board of appeals established under section
4 fourteen or a board of selectmen may grant a variance or change
5 in any zoning by-law requiring a certain number of parking
6 spaces be provided for multiple design structures in so far as
7 said by-law relates to state-aided housing for the elderly projects.
