AN ACT AUTHORIZING REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITIES TO ENGAGE IN REHABILITATION WITHIN AN URBAN RENEWAL AREA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 26JJJ of the General Laws, Chapter 121 is hereby
- 2 amended by adding at the end the following paragraph: —
- 3 That in a city or town in which a redevelopment authority
- 4 has been organized, such redevelopment authority shall have
- 5 the same powers as a housing authority to engage in rehabilita-
- 6 tion of dwellings within an urban renewal area under sec-
- 7 tions 26III and 26JJJ of chapter 121 of the General Laws
- 8 and any other applicable sections thereof.
