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Accompanying the third recommendation of the Health, Welfare and Retirement Trust Funds Board (House, No. 33). Labor and Industries.

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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PENALTY FOR KNOWINGLY FAILING TO MAKE AGREED CONTRIBUTIONS TO HEALTH, WELFARE AND RETIREMENT TRUST FUNDS FOR THE BENEFIT OF EMPLOYEES AND THEIR DEPENDENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 151D of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out section 10 as amended by chapter 467 of the acts  
3 of 1964 and inserting in place thereof the following section:—  
4 *Section 10.* In addition to any other penalty or punishment  
5 otherwise prescribed by law any person or employer, and the  
6 president, secretary, and treasurer, or officers exercising corre-  
7 sponding functions, of a corporation which is an employer, who  
8 is party to an agreement to pay or provide the contributions  
9 covered by this chapter or who is so required to pay these con-  
10 tributions under the terms of sections twenty-six and twenty-  
11 seven of chapter one hundred and forty-nine, and who refuses  
12 or knowingly fails or grossly neglects to pay such contributions  
13 or payments within thirty days after such payments are required  
14 to be made shall be punished by a fine of five hundred dollars or  
15 by imprisonment in a jail or house of correction for not more than  
16 one year or both.
