## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE REIMBURSEMENT OF CITIES AND TOWNS FOR EXPENSES INCURRED FOR THE BURIAL OF CERTAIN DEPENDENTS OF VETERANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 8 of chapter 115 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the second sentence of said section and  
3 inserting therein the following:—No city or town shall be  
4 reimbursed under this section for any amount so expended  
5 for any single burial if the total expense of said burial, exclu-  
6 sive of the purchase price of the grave, the cost of the grave  
7 opening and the cost of a cement vault liner, if one is required  
8 by the cemetery regulations, by whomsoever incurred, exceeds  
9 three hundred dollars for a child under the age of seven, or  
10 seven hundred and fifty dollars for any other person.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I

Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2

The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
