AN ACT AUTHORIZING CERTAIN PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS FROM THE
COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES OF THE GARDNER STATE HOSPITAL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Deductions on payroll schedules may be made from the salary
2 of any employee of the Gardner state hospital of any amount
3 which such employee may specify in writing to the treasurer of
4 the Gardner state hospital for payment to the Gardner state
5 hospital credit union. Any such authorization may be with-
6 drawn by the employee by giving at least sixty days notice in
7 writing of such withdrawal to the treasurer of the Gardner state
8 hospital and by filing a copy thereof with the treasurer of the
9 Gardner state hospital credit union. The treasurer of the Gard-
10 ner state hospital shall deduct from the salary of such employee
11 such amounts as may be specified in his written order and trans-
12 mit the sum deducted to such credit union; provided, that the
13 county treasurer is satisfied that the treasurer of such credit
14 union has given to the credit union a bond in a form approved
15 by the county treasurer, for the faithful performance of his duties,
16 in a sum and with such surety or sureties as are satisfactory to the
17 county treasurer.
