AN ACT PROVIDING LIFE TENURE FOR GEORGE W. WYMAN, INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF SUPERINTENDENT OF STREETS OF THE TOWN OF WESTFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of office of George W. Wyman, incum-
2 bent of the office of superintendent of streets of the town of
3 Westford shall be unlimited, but he may be removed therefrom
4 for cause after hearing in the manner provided by section forty-
5 three of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the voters of the
2 town of Westford at the annual town meeting in the current
3 year in the form of the following question, which shall be placed
4 upon the official ballot to be used for the election of town officers
5 at said meeting: — “Shall an act passed by the General Court
6 in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-six, entitled ‘An Act
7 providing life tenure for George W. Wyman, incumbent of the
8 office of superintendent of streets of the town of Westford’, be
9 accepted?” If a majority of the votes in answer to said question
10 is in the affirmative, this act shall thereupon take full effect,
11 but not otherwise.
