
Crowell State Park, in the town of Sandwich to the Sandwich water district, subject to such conditions as the deputy commissioner in consultation with the department of environmental management may prescribe.

Said easement is shown on a plan of land entitled "Plan of Utility Easement in Sandwich, MA." by Kingsbury Surveying Co., Inc. dated February fifteenth, nineteen hundred and ninety which is on file in the offices of the Sandwich water district.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 348. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF FALMOUTH TO RELEASE ITS SANDING RIGHTS IN A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Falmouth is hereby authorized to release its sanding rights in a certain parcel of land in said town. Said parcel is shown as Parcel "A" on a plan entitled "Plan of Land for James Kinchla, East Falmouth, Barnstable County, Mass.," dated September 26, 1989.

SECTION 2. In consideration of the release authorized by section one, James Kinchla shall convey to the town of Falmouth all his rights, title and interest in a certain parcel of land shown as Parcel B on said plan and shall record a building restriction on Parcel A.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 349. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY KNOWN AS THE TOWN OF METHUEN TO TRANSFER CONTROL OF CERTAIN RECREATIONAL LAND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The city known as the town of Methuen, acting by and through its town manager, with approval of its town council, is hereby authorized to transfer the care, custody and control of a certain parcel of land presently used as a recreational area to the Methuen department of public works to use as a park and ride facility.

Said parcel is more particularly described as: Beginning at a point on the northerly side of Pelham Street at a point where Lot 1 touches Lot 2 on said plan; thence travelling westerly on said Pelham Street, N 69°36'00" W, a distance of 154 feet to a point; thence travelling north-northwest, N 04°12'00" W, 293.15 feet to a point; thence travelling northeasterly, N 58°38'00", a distance of 315.74 feet to a point; thence travelling southeasterly, S 04°39'45" E, a distance of 282 feet to a point; thence travelling southwesterly, S 28°55'19" W, a distance of 262 feet to the point of origin.

Said parcel consists of 2.32 acres, plus or minus, and is shown as Lot 1 on a "Plan of Land in Methuen, MA, Prepared for the Town of Methuen", dated June 1, 1990, by Thomas F. Doucette, registered land surveyor which is on file with said department.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 350. AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE EASTERN HAMPSHIRE COUNTY REGIONAL REFUSE DISTRICT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established the Eastern Hampshire Regional Refuse District, a body politic and corporate, hereinafter referred to as the district. Said district shall function as a regional solid waste management district in accordance with sections forty-four A to forty-four L, inclusive, of chapter forty of the General Laws, with the powers provided therein and in accordance with the provisions of the regional agreement adopted by member municipalities of said district. All provisions of said regional agreement are hereby ratified, validated and confirmed, notwithstanding any failure of said regional agreement or its manner of adoption to comply with said chapter forty.

The district is created for the purpose of providing solid waste disposal services for its member municipalities and the residents thereof and for others whom the district may want to contract in accordance with any agreements reached by member municipalities. The district shall be composed of and shall include all of the lands and residents within the towns of Amherst, Belchertown, and Hadley, which, by vote at an annual town meeting, accept the provisions of this act and thereby agree to participate in its creation, and such other municipalities as are subsequently admitted to the district. The municipalities composing the district shall constitute its membership and are herein designated as member municipalities.

SECTION 2. In addition to the powers conferred by statute and the regional
