## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PERMANENT AUTOMOBILE ACCIDENT COMMISSION.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of  
2 four members of the senate, four members of the house of  
3 representatives, and three persons to be appointed by the  
4 governor, one of whom shall be a representative of the Massa-  
5 chusetts bar association, one a member of the judicial council  
6 and one a representative of the insurance companies, is hereby  
7 established for the purpose of making an investigation and  
8 study of the advisability of establishing an Automobile Acci-  
9 dent Commission patterned after the Industrial Accident Com-  
10 mission. Such investigation and study would evaluate the  
11 immediate and long range needs of the public for such a  
12 commission as a means of providing a prompt remedy and  
13 fair compensation for motor vehicle accident victims.
