AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF AGRICULTURE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 20 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in section 1 of chapter 674 of the acts of 1954, is
3 hereby amended by striking out the sixth and seventh sentences
4 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:— The
5 governor shall appoint a commissioner who shall serve for a term
6 of four years and shall have charge of the administration of the
7 department.

1 SECTION 2. Said chapter 20 is hereby further amended by
2 striking out section 2, as most recently amended by section 41
3 of chapter 801 of the acts of 1963, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following section:— *Section 2.* Upon the expiration of the
5 term of office of a commissioner, his successor shall be appointed
6 by the governor. The commissioner shall receive such salary,
7 not exceeding eleven thousand dollars, as the governor may de-
8 termine, and traveling expenses incurred in his official duties,
9 and shall devote his full time during business hours to the duties
10 of his office.
