By Mr. Longworth of Methuen, petition of Richard E. McLaughlin and William Longworth for requiring school buses to display blinking red lights in the forward direction when taking on passengers. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT TO REQUIRE SCHOOL BUSES TO DISPLAY BLINKING RED LIGHTS IN THE FORWARD DIRECTION WHEN TAKING ON PASSENGERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7B of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended,
2 is hereby further amended by striking out the sentence num-
3 bered (7) and inserting the following: — (7) Each school bus
4 shall be equipped with red front and rear blinker lights of a
5 type to be approved by the registrar, which shall be left flash-
6 ing when children are entering or leaving said bus.
