RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ERECTION WITHIN THE GOVERNMENT CENTER OF A STATUE OR OTHER SUITABLE MEMORIAL TO COMMEMORATE THE LATE JAMES M. CURLEY.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of three mem-  
2 bers of the house of representatives, two members of the senate,  
3 and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby  
4 established for the purpose of making a study relative to the  
5 erection within the government center of a statue or other suit-  
6 able memorial to commemorate the late James M. Curley, four  
7 times mayor of the city of Boston and former congressman and  
8 governor.
