AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN OPEN-AIR PARKING FACILITY NEAR HARVARD AVENUE IN THE BRIGHTON DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The real property board of the city of Boston is hereby
2 authorized and directed to establish an open-air parking fa-
3 cility to accommodate not less than fifty motor vehicles in
4 the Brighton section of the city of Boston in the vicinity of
5 Harvard avenue, and to expend for the purpose any available
6 funds, including the proceeds of any borrowings authorized
7 under the provisions of chapter four hundred and seventy-
8 four of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-six, as hereto-
9 fore or hereafter amended.
