AN ACT INCREASING LICENSE FEE OF ADJUSTERS OF FIRE LOSSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 14 of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 522 of the acts of 1956, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out the 14th paragraph
4 and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—

5 For each license or renewal thereof to an adjuster of fire
6 losses under section one hundred and seventy two, two hundred
7 and fifty dollars.
