RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE REORGANIZATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, seven members of the house of rep-
3 resentatives, and seven persons to be appointed by the gov-
4 ernor, one of whom shall be a member of the Massachusetts
5 Audubon Society, one a member of the Massachusetts Forest
6 and Park Association, one a member of the Council of Sports-
7 men's Clubs of Massachusetts, one a member of the Massa-
8 chusetts Association of Conservation Districts, and one a
9 member of the Massachusetts Wildlife Federation is hereby
10 established for the purpose of making a study of the depart-
11 ment of natural resources and its various subdivisions relative
12 to the correlation and unification of administrative proce-
13 dures, statutory composition and policy establishment pursu-
14 ant to its operation and organization.

15 Said commission shall report to the General Court the re-
16 sults of its study and its recommendations together with
17 drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations
18 into effect, by filing same with the clerk of the house of rep-
19 resentatives on or before the first Wednesday in December,
20 nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
