AN ACT TO ASSURE ADEQUATE COMPETITION IN BIDDING FOR PUBLIC BUILDING PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (1), section 44I, chapter 149 of the General Laws
2 is hereby further amended by adding after the first sentence the
3 following: — On construction and reconstruction contracts under
4 this chapter (but not on contracts for alteration, remodelling,
5 repair or demolition) if any general bidder is precluded from
6 using every sub-bid filed for any such sub-trade, the awarding
7 authority shall state, in an addendum issued with the list of
8 sub-bidders required by section forty-four H, an amount which
9 may be included by general bidders under Item 2 of the general
10 bid form for such sub-trade. Every general bidder may either
11 use such amount or name any sub-bidder he is not precluded
12 from using.
