AN ACT TO PROVIDE A DEGREE OF EQUITY OF THE TAX PAID BY CORPORATIONS AND OTHERS WHICH PROVIDE OR ARRANGE TO PROVIDE MAJOR MEDICAL HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 63 of the General Laws is hereby amended by add-
2 ing after section 24 the following new section:—

3 *Section 24A.* In determining the amount of tax payable
4 under sections twenty, twenty-one, twenty-two and twenty-
5 three there shall be deducted the premium on all group or indi-
6 vidual policies of so-called major medical insurance authorized
7 and issued pursuant to section one hundred and ten of chapter
8 one hundred and seventy-five.
