AN ACT PROVIDING TENURE OF OFFICE UNTIL AGE SEVENTY FOR WILLIAM F. BUSBY, INCUMBENT OF OFFICE OF CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF LOWELL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. William F. Busby, incumbent of the office of
2 city clerk of the city of Lowell, shall hold said office during
3 good behavior until he reaches seventy, unless incapacitated
4 by physical or mental disability from performing the duties
5 thereof, but he may be removed therefrom for cause after hear-
6 ing in the manner prescribed by section forty-three of chapter
7 thirty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance
2 by the city of Lowell.
