## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO ESTABLISH A YOUTH WORKSHOP FOR RETARDED CHILDREN IN THE CITY OF MALDEN FOR THE USE OF SUCH CHILDREN FROM SAID CITY AND THE CITIES OF EVERETT AND MELROSE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The department of education is hereby au-  
2 thorized and directed to establish a youth workshop for re-  
3 tarded children in the city of Malden for the purpose of pro-  
4 viding job training and vocational education for such children  
5 who are educable under the provisions of section forty-six of  
6 chapter seventy-one of the General Laws and who reside in the  
7 cities of Malden, Everett and Melrose.

1 SECTION 2. Preference of location of such workshop shall  
2 be given to the premises now or formerly occupied by the  
3 United States Post Office in the city of Malden.
