AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPEAL OF CERTAIN GRIEVANCES OF STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 49 of chapter 30 of the General Laws,
2 as amended by chapter 690 of the acts of 1962, is hereby
3 further amended by adding the following words to the second
4 sentence thereof: — ; and the director of personnel and stand-
5 ardization is hereby authorized to create a so-called “excess
6 quota position” to grant relief to the aggrieved employee but
7 such “excess quota position” shall terminate upon the pas-
8 sage of the next regular appropriation act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective on July first,
2 nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
