AN ACT TO RESTORE SICK LEAVE BENEFITS TO WHICH BEATRICE LEVY WAS ENTITLED PRIOR TO JANUARY, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-TWO.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special  
2 law to the contrary, Beatrice Levy, a disabled veteran of  
3 World War II and an employee of the commonwealth of Mas-  
4 sachusetts from December, nineteen hundred and thirty-six to  
5 the present time, except for service in the city of Boston from  
6 August, nineteen hundred and forty-nine to January, nine-  
7 teen hundred and sixty-two, shall be credited with all sick  
8 leave benefits to which she was entitled prior to said January,  
9 nineteen hundred and sixty-two and lost under provisions of  
10 law then governing sick leave.
