AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF LABOR AND MATERIAL
BONDS FOR BUILDINGS ON PRIVATE LANDS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 Section 29A of chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby
