RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE LAWS RELATING TO MUNICIPAL RECORDS AND TO THE MANAGEMENT AND PROTECTION OF SUCH RECORDS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 two members of the senate, three members of the house of rep-
3 resentatives, one person to be appointed by the secretary of
4 the commonwealth, one person to be appointed by the attorney
5 general, one person to be appointed by the Massachusetts Se-
6 lectman's Association, one person to be appointed by the Town
7 Clerks' Association, one person to be appointed by the City
8 Clerks' Association, one person to be appointed by the Massa-
9 chusetts Historical Society, and one person to be appointed by
10 the Boston Chapter of the American Records Management As-
11 sociation is hereby established for the purpose of making a
12 study of the laws relating to municipal records in the common-
13 wealth and of methods of improving the management of such
14 records and of protecting records of historical value.
