
SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and nineteen of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-seven is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The board of park commissioners of the city of Everett shall have all the powers and duties now vested in the Everett stadium and athletic field commission and all assets and liabilities of said commission shall be transferred to said board.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section two of chapter forty-five of the General Laws, the board of park commissioners in the city of Everett shall consist of seven members, five of whom shall be appointed under the provisions of said section two of said chapter forty-five and one of whom shall be the principal of Everett high school, ex officio, and one of whom shall be a member of the Everett school committee who shall be appointed by the mayor of the city of Everett.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 454. AN ACT RELATIVE TO LIQUOR LIABILITY JOINT UNDERWRITING ASSOCIATION.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately regulate the Joint Underwriting Association for Liquor Liability, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 223 of the acts of 1985 is hereby amended by striking out section 13, as most recently amended by chapter 657 of the acts of 1989, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 13. Section one to twelve, inclusive, of this act shall expire on December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and ninety-one.

Chapter 455. AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE TOWN OF SWAMPSCOTT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law or

rule to the contrary, the position of clerical employee at the town administration building and the position of secretary to the police department in the town of Swampscott shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. The provisions of section one shall not impair the civil service status of any person holding the position of clerical employee at the town administration building or the position of secretary to the police department in the town of Swampscott on the effective date of the act.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 456. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMMISSION ON EMPLOYMENT OF THE HANDICAPPED.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately change the name, membership and purpose of the commission on employment of the handicapped, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 17 of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 24, the words "employment of the handicapped" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- the employment of people with disabilities.

SECTION 2. Said chapter 6 is hereby further amended by striking out the caption preceding section 105, as so appearing.

SECTION 3. Said chapter 6 is hereby further amended by striking out section 105, as amended by section 4 of chapter 177 of the acts of 1990, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 105. There shall be a commission on the employment of people with disabilities, in this section and sections one hundred and six and one hundred and seven called the commission, consisting of the secretary of communities and development, the secretary of consumer affairs and business regulation, the secretary of economic affairs, the secretary of human services, the secretary of labor, the secretary of transportation and construction, the commissioner of the Massachusetts commission for the blind, the commissioner of the commission for the deaf and hard of hearing, the commissioner of corrections, the commissioner of education, the commissioner of employment and training, the commissioner of
