AN ACT LIMITING LEAVES OF ABSENCE BY CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF CITIES OPERATING UNDER PLAN E CHARTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 105 of chapter 43 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 15 of chapter 378 of the acts of
3 1938, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof
4 the following sentence: — No permanent employee appointed
5 by the city manager subject to the provisions of chapter thirty-
6 one shall be granted leave of absence for a period in excess of
7 three years if the purpose of such leave is to assume a position in
8 public employment for which he will receive compensation in
9 excess of that received in such city or which position carries
10 with it greater supervisory power than that formerly held by
11 him.
