AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY CERTIFICATES TO CERTAIN FORMER MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by section 2D of chapter 613 of the acts of
3 1958, is hereby further amended by adding at the end the fol-
4 lowing sentence:— The department shall grant a high school
5 equivalency certificate to any resident of the commonwealth
6 who was a member of the armed forces of the United States and
7 who has not received a high school diploma if such resident has
8 satisfactorily passed the high school equivalency test, com-
9 monly known as the G.E.D. test, administered by the armed
10 forces of the United States.
