## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT CONFIRMING THE POWER OF THE BOSTON REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE FOR URBAN RENEWAL PURPOSES CERTAIN RAILROAD PROPERTY IN THE CHARLESTOWN DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the Boston  
2 Redevelopment Authority's powers pursuant to section twenty-  
3 six P of chapter one hundred and twenty-one of the General  
4 Laws shall include the power to acquire by purchase, lease, gift,  
5 bequest or grant, or by eminent domain under chapter seventy-  
6 nine or chapter eighty A, or otherwise, property within the area  
7 in the Charlestown district of the city of Boston covered by  
8 the urban renewal plan approved by the mayor of said city  
9 with the approval of the city council thereof on June seventh,  
10 nineteen hundred and sixty-five, although such property be  
11 held or used for railroad purposes.
