AN ACT PERMITTING BRANCH OFFICES OF NEW YORK STOCK EXCHANGE FIRMS TO REMAIN OPEN FOR BUSINESS ON CERTAIN LEGAL HOLIDAYS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 15 of chapter 137 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end the following sentence:—
3 Branch offices of New York stock exchange firms may remain
4 open for business on any legal holiday whenever the New York
5 stock exchange remains open without being required to secure
6 a permit under the provisions of this section.
