By Mr. O'Farrell of Malden, petition of George H. O'Farrell that employees of public authorities who are delegates to state or national conventions of certain veterans' organizations be permitted to attend such conventions without loss of pay or vacation leave. State Administration.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT EMPLOYEES OF ALL PUBLIC AUTHORITIES WHO ARE DELEGATES TO A STATE OR NATIONAL CONVENTION OF CERTAIN VETERANS' ORGANIZATIONS MAY ATTEND SUCH CONVENTION WITHOUT LOSS OF PAY OR VACATION LEAVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out section 111J, inserted by chapter 412 of the acts of
3 1963, and inserting in place thereof the following section:—

4 *Section 111J.* Any employee of a city or town or public
5 authority who is a delegate or alternate to a state or national
6 convention of a veterans organization chartered by the Con-
7 gress of the United States may, when authorized by the board
8 or officer having the power to remove him, attend such conven-
9 tion without loss of pay or vacation leave.
